TORONTO, August 9, 2016 ---- Toronto's International Festival of Authors is thrilled to present the preliminary lineup for the Festival's 37th edition (Harbourfront Centre, October 20 to 30, 2016).

IFOA is the premier event of its kind in Toronto, offering audiences access to favourite authors from around the globe and introducing readers to a curated list of new voices. **The Festival boasts over 200 participants** presenting works of diverse genres from literary fiction to memoir, from poetry to thriller. This fall, we will spotlight **graphic novels**, **contemporary Irish literature and nonfiction**.
